PARTIES

This Licence Agreement is entered into by and between

- (1) **EMERALD PUBLISHING LIMITED** incorporated and registered in England & Wales with company number 03080506 whose registered office is at Floor 5, Northspring, 21-23 Wellington Street, Leeds, England, LS1 4DL ("**Emerald**")

and

(2) [Institution XY] located at [Address] (the "Licensee") in the framework of a consortium negotiated and organised by the Central Head Office of the Austrian Academic Library Consortium. In addition, all other members of KEMÖ are entitled to join this contract under the conditions regulated therein by way of signing independent agreements with Emerald. This shall also apply to new members joining the KEMÖ after the conclusion of this contract, whereby these are exclusively Austrian universities or private universities with associated university hospitals, universities of applied sciences, provincial libraries, the Austrian National Library as well as other scientific information, research information, research, research promotion and educational institutions based in Austria as well as the Austrian Library Network and Service GmbH, all based in Austria.

BACKGROUND

- (1) Emerald is the owner of intellectual property rights, or has licensing rights in, copyright works within its online products.
- (2) The Licensees wish to access and use Emerald's copyright works on the terms of this Licence.

AGREED TERMS

1. INTERPRETATION

- 1.1 The definitions and rules of interpretation in this Clause apply in this Licence.

Archive: has the meaning given in Clause 16.

Austrian Academic Library Consortium: means the consortium that provides to its institutional members collaboration and support for the purchase and management of databases, e-journals and e-books.

Authentication: means secure authentication by use of Internet Protocol Address or via single-sign-on-services (e.g. Shibboleth) or a proxy service.

Authors: means authors affiliated with the Licensee

Authorised Users: means current members of the faculty and other staff of the Licensee (whether on a permanent, temporary, contract or visiting basis including emeriti) and individuals who are currently registered students at the Licensee's institution and who are permitted to access the Secure Network

from within the Licensee's campus (including but not limited to Authorised Users' offices and homes, halls of residence and student dormitories) and who have been issued by the Licensee with a password or other authentication and whose conduct is subject to regulation by the Licensee, together with other persons ("Walk-In-Users") who are permitted to use the Licensee's library or information service and access the Secure Network but only within the Licensee's campus.

Calendar Year: means 1 January to 31 December.

Commercial Use: means use of the Licensed Materials for the purposes of any monetary or other type of valuable consideration, transfer, sale, resale, loan, hire, licence, sub-licence or other form of exploitation of the Licensed Materials. For the avoidance of doubt, the use by the Licensee or Authorised Users of the Licensed Materials in the course of research funded by a commercial organisation is not deemed to constitute Commercial Use.

COUNTER: means Counting Online Usage of Networked Electronic Resources.

Course Packs: means a collection or compilation of printed materials (e.g. book chapters, journal articles) assembled by members of staff of the Licensee for use by Authorised Users in a class for the purpose of instruction and education.

Derivative Works: means work generated or developed following the date of this Licence which is based on the Licensed Materials or an underlying work in relation to this.

Electronic Reserve: means electronic copies of materials (e.g. book chapters, journal articles) made and stored on a Secure Network by the Licensee for use only by Authorised Users in connection with specific courses of instruction offered by the Licensee to its Authorised Users.

Eligible Author: means corresponding authors whose primary affiliation is with the Licensee as stated in the Eligible Content.

Eligible Content: means content that is accepted for publication by Emerald in accordance with the applicable acceptance criteria (including editorial and peer review standards). **End User Terms:** the terms applicable to use of Emerald's electronic database by Authorised Users, as stated on the Publisher's website

(http://www.emeraldgrouppublishing.com/about/policies/end_user_terms.pdf).

In the event that the End User Terms conflict with this agreement, the provision of this agreement shall take precedence.

Group Companies: Emerald's holding company and all subsidiaries owned by such holding company.

Head Office: Acting as the main link between the Licensee and the Licensor, the Head Office of the Austrian Academic Library Consortium assumes the following tasks: leading negotiations with the Licensor, coordinating the process of drawing up and having license agreements signed by the Licensee

and Licensor and coordinating the payment process in case of central invoicing.

Library Premises: means the physical premises of the library or libraries operated by the Licensee.

Licence: means this licence agreement between Emerald and the Licensee.

Licence Fee: means the licence fee in Schedule 2.

Licensed Materials: means the copyright works identified in Schedule 1.

Participating Institutional Members means the Licensee and any other individual members of the Austrian Academic Library Consortium that have entered into an agreement with Emerald for access to its content in the applicable period in the form negotiated by Head Office for that period;

Reserved Rights: means all rights in, or in relation to, the Licensed Materials that are not expressly granted to the Licensee under this Licence, including any rights in Derivative Works which Emerald may create or acquire, and any other rights (whether known now, or created later, and whether or not in the contemplation of the parties at the time of this Licence).

Secure Network: means a network (whether a standalone network or a virtual network within the internet) which is only accessible to Authorised Users approved by the Licensee whose identity is authenticated by secure authentication regulations by the Licensee.

Subscription Period: means the period during which the Licensed Materials are licensed by the Licensee from Emerald, as indicated in the Schedules.

Virtual Learning Environment: means a software system supporting teaching and learning, accessed through a Secure Network operated by the Licensee for use only by Authorised Users.

Voucher: means a voucher representing prepaid article processing charge where one voucher redeems one item of Eligible Content.

1.2 The headings in this Licence do not affect its interpretation. Except where the context otherwise requires, references to Clauses and Schedules are to clauses and schedules of this Licence.

1.3 Unless the context otherwise requires:

- (a) a reference to one gender includes a reference to the other genders; and
- (b) references to "including" or "includes" shall be deemed to have the words "without limitation" inserted after them.

- 1.4 In the case of conflict or ambiguity between any provision contained in the body of this Licence and any provision contained in the Schedules, the provision in the body of this Licence shall take precedence.
- 1.5 Words in the singular include the plural and those in the plural include the singular.
- 1.6 A **person** includes a natural person, corporate or unincorporated body (whether or not having separate legal personality).

2. AGREEMENT AND TERM

- 2.1 The term of this Agreement will be for 3 (three) years, which begins on 1st January 2026 and will remain in force until 31st December 2028, unless terminated earlier as provided in Clause 15. The Licensee may renew this Agreement for successive one-year term (optional year) by giving written notice to the Licensor at least ninety (90) days prior to the expiration of the then current term and subject to payment of the Fees for the applicable year. The total duration of this Agreement, including the exercise of any options under this clause, will not exceed 4 (four) years. The Licensee acknowledges that the title listing comprising the Licensed Materials may change from year to year.
- 2.2 Emerald agrees to grant to the Licensee the non-exclusive and non-transferable right for the purposes of research, education, teaching and private study to give Authorised Users access to and permission to use the Licensed Materials and the respective metadata for the Subscription Period through a Secure Network subject to the terms and conditions of this Licence, and the Licensee agrees to pay the Licence Fee.
- 2.3 This Licence shall commence at the beginning of the Subscription Period for each of the Licensed Materials, as set out in the Schedules. This Licence shall automatically expire and terminate at the end of the Subscription Period unless the parties have previously agreed to renew it in writing.
- 2.4 On termination or expiry of this Licence, Emerald shall provide continuous access at no extra costs in perpetuity for Authorised Users to that part of the Licensed Materials which was published and paid for within the Subscription Period, either through a Secure Network or from the Archive described in Clause 16. This perpetual access right is subject to the terms of this Licence and Emerald may terminate this arrangement if either (a) the Licensee is in breach of any terms; or (b) Emerald no longer has the right to grant such access to the Licensee (in which case termination of the perpetual access right shall be for the affected part of the Licensed Materials only). In the case of (b) the contracting parties must negotiate a refund from Emerald to the Licensee. For clarification, perpetual access rights that have been granted in previous

agreements remain in full force and effect subject to the terms of such agreement.

- 2.5 Complimentary archive access may be provided within the framework of this agreement without additional costs at the discretion of Emerald and content comprised in any such archives may be removed or substituted from time to time on reasonable notice from Emerald to the Licensee. The Licensee's complimentary access to archives will cease on expiry of the relevant Subscription Period.

3. USAGE AND RIGHTS

3.1 Subject to payment of the Licence Fee, the Licensee may:

- (a) provide Authorised Users with an integrated access and index to the Licensed Materials and all other similar material acquired from other sources through a Secure Network. The Licensed Materials or parts thereof may be compiled, indexed and/or catalogued including the header data and abstracts (but, for the avoidance of doubt, excluding full text journal articles and book titles) by the Licensee. Anything thereby created or compiled may be integrated into the products and services of the Licensee. Metadata (abstract XML only) may be integrated into any other library and information system (including but not limited to search engines of commercial corporations provided that the metadata is not sold, lent, re-licensed, or distributed in any manner).
- (b) provide a reasonable amount of printed or electronic copies of single articles or items at the request of individual Authorised Users; and
- (c) display, download or print the Licensed Materials for the purpose of internal marketing or testing or for training Authorised Users or groups of Authorised Users.
- (d) incorporate links to the Licensed Materials on the Licensee's intranet and internet websites.
- (e) run test routines, verifying access to all licensed items. Testing conditions will be clearly defined. Usage generated by test runs will not be part of the usage statistics delivered.
- (f) in case of technical breakdowns (including but not limited to downtimes of Emerald's Platform or to incorrect administered IP ranges) provide Authorised Users with electronic copies of single articles and items of the Licensed Materials provided they are deleted once the technical breakdown has been rectified.

- (g) may store a single copy of an individual document of the Licensed Materials within secure personal Bibliographic Reference Management Systems.

3.2 Subject to payment of the Licence Fee by the Licensee, Authorised Users may:

- (a) access, search, view, retrieve and display on screen the Licensed Materials;
- (b) print reasonable amounts or download and save individual articles or items of the Licensed Materials for research, educational and teaching purposes and for private study;
- (c) distribute a single copy of individual articles or single chapters in print or electronic form to other Authorised Users or to other individual scholars collaborating with Authorised Users but only for the purposes of fair dealing for non-commercial research and educational purposes;
- (d) use figures, tables and brief excerpts from the Licensed Materials in the Authorised User's own scientific, scholarly and educational works, with appropriate acknowledgment of the source, title, author and Emerald's name as copyright owner;
- (e) publicly display individual articles or items of the Licensed Materials as part of a presentation at a seminar, conference, or workshop, or other such similar activity with appropriate acknowledgment of the source, title, author and Emerald's name as copyright owner; and
- (f) make such copies of training material and network such training material as may be required for the purpose of using the Licensed Materials in accordance with this Licence.
- (g) Notwithstanding the provisions of this Agreement, Emerald acknowledges the right of the Licensee to use the Licensed Materials for the purposes of computational analysis using automated techniques to analyse text and data for patterns and trends ("TDM"), provided such use is for non-commercial research purposes only.
- (h) Emerald grants to the Licensee, subject to and in accordance with the terms of this Agreement a non-exclusive licence to use the Licensed Materials and its bibliographical metadata associated with the Licensed Materials project in its Virtual Learning Environment, managed learning environments, virtual research environments and library environments.

3.3 Nothing in this Licence shall in any way exclude, modify or affect any of the Licensee's statutory rights under copyright laws.

3.4 All rights in and to the Licensed Materials not expressly granted to the Licensee under this Licence are reserved to Emerald and its licensors.

4. INTER LIBRARY LOAN

4.1 The Licensee shall be permitted to use reasonable amounts of the Licensed Materials (single articles but not complete issues) to fulfil requests from other libraries within Austria called Inter-Library Loan or Document Delivery requests under the following conditions:

- (a) The full texts may be scanned and supplied in electronic way.
- (b) The electronic file shall be deleted immediately after printing and sending.
- (c) Full texts are permitted to print and to send it by post.
- (d) The commercial use by the Licensee or the recipient of the loan/delivery request shall not be allowed.
- (e) Authorized users may not remove or modify copyright notices that appear on Articles or in the Licensed Products.

5. COURSE PACKS, ELECTRONIC RESERVE AND VIRTUAL LEARNING

5.1 The Licensee may incorporate parts of the Licensed Materials in printed Course Packs, Electronic Reserve collections, study packs, resource lists and in any other material (including but not limited to multi-media works) and/or in virtual and managed environments (including but not limited to virtual learning environments, managed learning environments, virtual research environments and library environments) hosted by the Licensee on a Secure Network for use by Authorised Users only. Each such item incorporated shall carry appropriate acknowledgement of the source, title, author of the extract and Emerald's name. Course packs in non-electronic non-print perceptible form, such as audio or Braille, may also be offered by the Licensee to Authorised Users on the same terms as set out in this Clause 5.

6. ACCESSIBLE FORMATS

6.1 Licensor shall provide with reasonable efforts Content in a format that is perceivable and operable by persons with visual, perceptual, physical, or other print disabilities, and is usable with assistive devices. Licensor shall use reasonable efforts to conform to the ISO Standard (ISO/IEC 40500:2025) and will use reasonable efforts to comply with the Web Content Accessibility Guidelines published by the World Wide Web Consortium's Web Accessibility

Initiative, which may be found at <http://www.w3.org/WAI/GL/#Publications>. and use reasonable efforts to comply with the Marrakesh Treaty (<http://www.wipo.int/treaties/en/ip/marrakesh/>) and any applicable Austrian laws relating to accessibility in its efforts to ensure that the Licensed Materials are accessible to all Authorized Users. Licensee may alter or modify the Licensed Materials as necessary to provide an equivalent level of access to Authorized Users with disabilities if the Licensed Materials are not provided in Accessible Formats by Licensor. Course Packs in alternate formats may also be offered to Authorized Users that require Accessible Formats.

7. PROHIBITED USES

7.1 Neither the Licensee nor the Authorised Users may:

- (a) use all or part of the Licensed Materials for Commercial Use
- (b) remove or alter the authors' names or Emerald's copyright notices or other means of identification as they appear on the Licensed Materials;
- (c) make print or electronic copies of multiple extracts or make multiple copies of any part of the Licensed Materials for any purpose other than expressly permitted by this Licence;
- (d) download or distribute any part of the Licensed Materials on any electronic system or network, including without limitation the internet and world wide web, other than a Secure Network, except where otherwise expressly permitted by this Licence;
- (e) prepare, publish or distribute Derivative Works or works which combine the Licensed Materials with any other material, other than as otherwise permitted by this Licence; or
- (f) alter, abridge, adapt or modify the Licensed Materials for any purpose whatsoever, except to the extent necessary to make them perceptible on a computer screen to Authorised Users. For the avoidance of doubt, no alteration of the words or their order is permitted unless permitted by mandatory law.

8. RESPONSIBILITIES OF EMERALD

8.1 Emerald agrees to:

- (a) make the Licensed Materials available to the Licensee in accordance with the terms of this Licence and through IP ranges or via single-sign-on-services (e.g. Shibboleth) or a proxy service. Remote access via the Secure Network is permitted for Authorised Users (but not Walk In Users);

- (b) make the Licensed Materials available to the Licensee on the basis of the charges agreed in the Licence Fee Offer;
- (c) following the Licensee's signature of this Licence, provide the Licensee with information sufficient to enable access to the Licensed Materials;
- (d) use reasonable efforts to provide the Licensed Materials with a quality of service consistent with industry standards. Continuous service shall be provided with an average of 99% up-time per month, with the 1% down-time including scheduled maintenance and repairs performed at a time to minimize inconvenience for the Licensee and its authorized Users. The service shall be restored as soon as possible in the event of an interruption of service. If the down-time exceeds more than five (5) days consecutively, Emerald will refund to the Licensee the amount of the Fees that is proportional to the amount of down-time. The Licensee shall at all times ensure that communication details (such as, without limitation, library administrator details) for the purposes of scheduled maintenance are kept up to date and that any changes shall be communicated to Emerald without delay
- (e) ensure that the Licensed Materials does not contain any viruses or other computer programming routines which are intended to damage or detrimentally interfere with, surreptitiously intercept or expropriate any system, data or personal data and it shall ensure that no known viruses for which detection and antidote software is generally available are coded or introduced into the Licensed Material.
- (f) provide customer support services to the Licensees and their Authorised Users by email or over the phone. This includes answering e-mail queries about the use, functionality and content of the Licensed Materials. Emerald shall use reasonable endeavours to respond within one working day to support requests of the Licensee;
- (g) provide means for the Licensee to update itself in the event of the following circumstances. Should the customer require more detailed information on any of the following subjects, the customer may request the information by sending an email to either of the following email address support@emeraldinsight.com
 - a. a product is taken from the platform;
 - b. a new product will be put on the platform;
 - c. a URL will be changed;
 - d. a product will be moved to another supplier;
 - e. a product will be discontinued; and/or

- f. a product will be changed in any way (mergers, splits etc.)
- 8.2 Emerald reserves the right at any time to withdraw from the Licensed Materials any item or part of an item for which it no longer retains the right to publish, or which it has reasonable grounds to believe infringes a third party's copyright or any other intellectual property right or is defamatory, obscene, unlawful or otherwise objectionable. If the withdrawal represents more than ten per cent (10%) of the Licensed Materials, Emerald shall give written notice to the Licensee of such withdrawal and refund to the Licensee that part of the fee that is in proportion to the amount of Licensed Materials withdrawn and the remaining un-expired portion of the Subscription Period.
- 8.3 Emerald will use its reasonable endeavours to be compliant with the COUNTER code of practice and incorporate the latest compliancy rules where applicable in relation to the Licensed Materials and Emerald's obligations under this Licence. The Standardized Usage Statistics Harvesting Initiative (SUSHI) Protocol will be supported.
- 8.4 All usage data shall be compiled by Emerald in a manner consistent with applicable privacy laws and any and all regulations of the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) in its current and future versions. Emerald will notify Licensee and its Authorized Users as soon as it is practicable if Licensor's systems are breached and the confidentiality of personally identifiable information is compromised. Licensor shall ensure that, to the extent that any personal data originating from the European Economic Area ("EEA") is transferred by Licensor to a processor or in a country or territory outside the EEA that has not received a binding adequacy decision by the European Commission, such transfer shall be subject to appropriate safeguards in accordance with mandatory applicable data protection legislation (including Article 46 of the GDPR). Processing of personal data shall be subject to applicable data protection legislation. It shall not be allowed to use personal data provided by the Licensee in relation to this Agreement for advertising purposes or provide that personal data to third parties except for sub-processors used for the performance of its obligations under this Agreement. Usage data and usage statistics shall only be provided to the Licensee except where anonymised or aggregated. For providing usage data and usage statistics where the Licensee or its Authorised users are identifiable, third party permission of the Licensee in writing shall be required. Licensor ensures the same level of data protection subject to GDPR if personal data is transferred and processed outside of the European Union. Emerald is obligated not to sell usage or personal data of users (Science Tracking).
- 8.5 Emerald shall permit the integration of the Licensed Materials (bibliographic citations and abstracts, but not full text journal articles or book titles) in web-

scale discovery services. The Licensee shall provide access to the Licensed Materials via Web-Scale Discovery Services to Authorised Users only.

8.6 Emerald shall make available metadata (bibliographic citations and other metadata) to external third party discovery services in order to enable the Licensees and their Authorised Users to search for the Licensed Materials. The Licensee may include the Licensed Materials in federated or metasearch services accessible only by their Authorised Users. Emerald shall, on request, supply a metadata feed to Licensees to enable this.

8.7 On termination of this License, Emerald shall, where necessary, and where Licensees request this, continue to supply a metadata feed (abstract xml) to Licensees relating to the subscription years of the Licensed Materials published and paid for during the Subscription Period for abstract and indexing purposes only.

9. LICENSEE RESPONSIBILITIES

9.1 The Licensee shall:

- (a) use all reasonable endeavours to ensure that all Authorised Users are aware of the importance of respecting the intellectual property rights in the Licensed Materials and shall notify Authorised Users of the terms and conditions of this Licence and take steps to protect the Licensed Materials from use which is not expressly authorised by this Licence;
- (b) use all reasonable endeavours to monitor compliance of rightful use of the Licenced Materials and as soon as practicable upon becoming aware of any unauthorised use of the Licensed Materials or other breach of this Licence, inform Emerald in writing of such unauthorised use or breach and take all reasonable and appropriate steps, including disciplinary action, both to ensure that such activity ceases and to prevent any recurrence; and
- (c) following the Licensee's signature of this License, provide Emerald with information sufficient to enable Emerald to provide access to the Licensed Materials.

9.2 The Licensee acknowledges that the copyright and other intellectual property rights in the Licensed Materials are the property of Emerald or its licensors.

10. FEES AND INVOICING

10.1 Emerald shall submit its invoice of charges to the Licensee for the Licence Fee in Schedule 2. Emerald shall not submit invoices earlier than one month before

the period that the Licence Fee relates to. Unless otherwise agreed, invoices will not charge for periods longer than one year. The Licensee has the option to choose whether the invoice is issued before or after the start of the respective subscription year. The parties acknowledge that the invoice shall be issued before the end of February.

- 10.2 For the avoidance of doubt, the Licence Fee shall be exclusive of any sales, use, value added, non-recoverable, withholding or other taxes and the Licensee shall be liable for any such taxes in addition to the Licence fee.
- 10.3 The Licensee shall pay Emerald the amount of the invoice submitted under Clause 10.1 within 30 (thirty) days of receiving the invoice.
- 10.4 Should the Licensee not pay the amount owing to Emerald on time, Emerald shall give the Licensee written notice of default, granting it a further 2 (two) month period in which to comply with its payment obligation. Upon that period expiring, the Licensee shall be deemed to be in default by operation of law and Emerald shall be entitled to suspend access to the Licensed Materials and charge the Licensee an interest rate of 2% above Barclays Bank plc base rate on any payment that is not paid on time. Such interest shall be calculated from the day on which the Licensee fell into default until the day on which the amount owing is received.

11. DELIVERY OF LICENSED MATERIALS

- 11.1 Emerald shall make the Licensed Materials available to the Licensee as soon as possible following receipt of the Licensees' correct IP range(s).

12. CONFIDENTIALITY AND PUBLICITY

- 12.1 For the purpose of this Clause, **Confidential Information** means the terms of this Licence, pricing detailed in Schedule 2 and details which Emerald and the Licensees ought reasonably to know is confidential information of the other party. Except to the extent set out in this Clause where disclosure is required by law, or where disclosure is expressly permitted elsewhere in this Licence, each party shall:
 - (a) treat the other party's Confidential Information as confidential; and
 - (b) subject to Clauses 12.2 and 12.3 below, not disclose the other party's Confidential Information to any other person without the owner's prior written consent.
- 12.2 Notwithstanding the above provisions, the Licensee consents to Emerald providing the details of the Licensee's customer account to Emerald's Group

Companies, associates, agents (for example, without limitation, EBSCO) and IT service providers, some of which are based outside the European Economic Area, only for the purpose of providing the products and services requested by the Licensee.

12.3 Clause 12.1 shall not apply to the extent that:

- (a) such information was in the possession of the party making the disclosure, without obligation of confidentiality, prior to its disclosure; or
- (b) such information was obtained from a third party without obligation of confidentiality; or
- (c) such information was already in the public domain at the time of disclosure otherwise than through a breach of this Licence; or
- (d) such information was independently developed without access to the other party's Confidential Information; or
- (e) the Freedom of Information Act (or any similar legislation anywhere in the world which regulates and requires certain disclosure by public bodies and governments) enables either party to lawfully disclose Confidential Information. Where disclosure is required pursuant to such legislation, the Licensee shall inform Emerald without delay.

12.4 Notwithstanding the above provisions, the Licensee grants to Emerald limited rights to use the Licensee's name and quotations in public relations and promotional material, subject to the prior written consent of the Licensee.

12.5 Notwithstanding the above provisions, all information in this agreement is not confidential for all members of Kooperation E-Medien Austria, regardless of whether they are a current contractual party of this agreement.

12.6 Notwithstanding the above provisions, publication of the Agreement on a platform such as ESAC by Licensee is permitted as long as any price information has been redacted.

13. WARRANTIES AND INDEMNIFICATION

13.1 Each party warrants to the other that it has full power and authority to enter into and perform its obligations under this Licence.

13.2 Emerald warrants to the Licensee that the Licensed Materials used as contemplated by this Licence do not infringe the copyright or any other intellectual property rights of any third party.

- 13.3 Subject to Clause 13.4, Emerald shall indemnify and hold the Licensee harmless from and against any direct loss, damage, costs, liability and expenses (including reasonable and properly incurred legal and professional fees) arising out of any legal action taken against a Licensee by a third party claiming actual or alleged infringement of such intellectual property rights. This indemnity shall not apply if the Licensee has used Licensed Materials in any way not expressly permitted by this Licence.
- 13.4 The indemnity in Clause 13.3 shall only apply to the extent that the Licensee:
- (a) promptly notifies Emerald in writing of any claim or suit relevant to the indemnity;
 - (b) where so required, allows Emerald control over such negotiations or litigation and/or the defence or settlement of such claim or suit;
 - (c) makes no representations, admissions, agreement or settlements in relation to such claim or suit without Emerald's prior written consent; and
 - (d) gives Emerald all information and assistance it may reasonably require.
- 13.5 Both parties shall not be liable to the other party for any special, exemplary, indirect or consequential loss of any kind (including loss of profits or revenues, loss of business, depletion of goodwill, loss of anticipated savings, loss of contract or business interruption) arising under or in connection with Licence, in particular arising out of the inability to use, or the use of, the Licensed Materials.
- 13.6 No party limits its liability for death or personal injury caused by its own negligence (or the negligence of its employees or agents), for fraud or for any other reason not permitted by law.
- 13.7 Except as provided in Clause 13.3 (Emerald's indemnity to Licensees) for which aggregate liability shall be limited to £3 million, and subject to Clause 13.6 above, Emerald's aggregate liability for all claims, losses or damages arising under or in connection with this Licence or any collateral agreement shall in no circumstances exceed £5,000 or the annual fees received from the Licensee (whichever is the higher sum).
- 13.8 Except as expressly provided in this Licence, all representations and warranties of any kind, expressed or implied, including but not limited to the accuracy of the information contained in the Licensed Materials, merchantability or fitness of use for a particular purpose are to the fullest extent permitted by law excluded from this Licence and accordingly the Licensed Materials are supplied "as is".

14. TRADE MARKS AND INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY

- 14.1 The parties will not register one another's trademarks, trade names or other indications of origin (or any other marks or symbols similar to them) and will only use them in the manner indicated by the relevant party.
- 14.2 The intellectual property rights in respect of the Licensed Materials vest in Emerald.

15. TERMINATION

- 15.1 Either Party may terminate this Agreement effective on 31 December of each year during the term (for the avoidance of doubt, with the first right arising on 31 December 2026) by giving written notice by 1 October of the respective year.
- 15.2 In addition to automatic expiry (unless renewed), this Licence may be terminated by notice in writing:
- (a) given by Emerald to the Licensee if the Licensee does not pay the fee due by the date required;
 - (b) given by Emerald to the Licensee if the Licensee commits a material breach or persistent breaches of the License and fails to remedy such breach or persistent breaches within 30 days of being notified by Emerald of such breach or breaches;
 - (c) given by the Licensee to Emerald if Emerald commits a material or persistent breach of any term of this Licence and fails to remedy the breach (if capable of remedy) within 30 days of notification in writing by the Licensee; or
 - (d) given by either party to the other if the other party becomes insolvent or becomes subject to bankruptcy, receivership, liquidation or administration.
- 15.3 On expiry or termination of this Licence all rights and obligations of the parties shall automatically terminate except for those rights or obligations which are stated to survive termination and those obligations in respect of the Licensed Materials to which access continues to be permitted as provided in Clauses 2.4 and 16.
- 15.4 On termination of this Licence under 15.2(b) above, the Licensee shall immediately cease to distribute or make available the Licensed Materials to Authorised Users and shall immediately return to Emerald or destroy all Licensed Materials locally stored in accordance with the rights granted in this Licence.

15.5 On termination of this Licence by the Licensee pursuant to the default of Emerald as specified in 15.2(c) above, Emerald shall refund to the Licensee the proportion of the fee that represents the paid but un-expired part of the Subscription Period.

15.6 Either party's delay or failure to perform any provision of this Agreement, as a result of circumstances beyond its control (including, without limitation, acts of third parties, terrorism, war, strikes, floods, governmental restrictions, power, telecommunications or internet failures, or damage to or destruction of any network facilities) (a **Force Majeure Event**) shall not constitute a breach of this Agreement and neither party shall have any liability or responsibility for failure to fulfil any obligation under this Agreement so long as and to the extent to which the fulfilment of such obligation is prevented, frustrated, hindered or delayed as a consequence of a Force Majeure Event.

16. LONG TERM PRESERVATION AND CONTINUOUS ACCESS

16.1 Emerald's journal collection has been placed into long-term preservation archives (including Portico, LOCKSS and CLOCKSS) and (subject to any relevant membership requirements), the Licensee and Authorised Users shall be able to access such Archive(s) in the event that such Licenced Materials would be permanently unavailable from Emerald. Access to the Archive(s) shall at all times be subject to the terms of this Licence and this Clause shall survive termination or expiry of this Licence.

16.2 Emerald will facilitate continuous access to and use of e-Journals which were published and paid for during the term of this Licence and previous similar agreements between Emerald and each Licensee, through Portico, LOCKSS and CLOCKSS if one or more of the following events ("trigger events") occurs:

- (a) a catastrophic and sustained failure of Emerald's delivery platform for a period longer than 90 days; or
- (b) Emerald stops operations; or
- (c) Emerald has stopped publishing and is no longer providing access to a title; or
- (d) Emerald no longer offers back issues for a period longer than 90 days.

16.3 The Licensed Materials will be accessible through Emerald's platform during and after termination of this License Agreement without additional charges. If Emerald went into liquidation the Licensed Materials will be accessible through Portico free of charge for the Licensee if they are member of Portico.

17. REMEDIES

Except as expressly provided in this Licence, the rights and remedies provided under this Licence are in addition to, and not exclusive of, any rights or remedies provided by law.

18. ENTIRE AGREEMENT

18.1 This Licence and its Schedules contain the whole agreement between the parties relating to the subject matter hereof and supersede all prior agreements, arrangements and understandings between the parties relating to that subject matter, whether oral or written.

18.2 Each party acknowledges that, in entering into this Licence, it does not rely on any statement, representation, assurance or warranty (whether it was made negligently or innocently) of any person (whether a party to this Licence or not) (**Representation**) other than as expressly set out in this Licence.

18.3 Each party agrees that the only rights and remedies available to it arising out of or in connection with a Representation shall be for breach of contract.

19. VARIATION

No variation of this Licence shall be effective unless it is in writing and signed by the parties (or their authorised representatives).

20. SEVERANCE

20.1 If any court or competent authority finds that any provision of this Licence (or part of any provision) is invalid, illegal or unenforceable, that provision or part-provision shall, to the extent required, be deemed to be deleted, and the validity and enforceability of the other provisions of this Licence shall not be affected.

20.2 If any invalid, unenforceable or illegal provision of this Licence would be valid, enforceable and legal if some part of it were deleted, the parties shall negotiate in good faith to amend such provision such that, as amended, it is legal, valid and enforceable, and, to the greatest extent possible, achieves the parties' original commercial intention.

21. COUNTERPARTS

This Licence may be executed in any number of counterparts, each of which when executed and delivered shall constitute an original of this Licence, but all

the counterparts shall together constitute the same Licence. A photocopy of this Licence shall be deemed an original.

22. THIRD PARTY RIGHTS

A person who is not a party to this Licence shall not have any rights to enforce any term of this Licence.

- 22.1 The rights of the parties to terminate, rescind or agree any variation, waiver or settlement under this Licence is not subject to the consent of any person that is not a party to this Licence.

23. WAIVER

Either party's waiver or failure to require performance by the other of any provision of this Agreement will not affect its full right to require such performance at any subsequent time, or be taken or held to be a waiver of the provision itself.

24. ASSIGNMENT

- 24.1 Except as permitted for under this Licence, neither this Licence nor any of the rights and obligations under it may be sub-contracted, assigned or novated by either party without obtaining the prior written consent of the other party.
- 24.2 The Licensee shall not sell, transfer, hire, rent, licence or sub-licence the Licensed Materials to any third party, save where that is expressly permitted in the terms of this Licence.

25. NO PARTNERSHIP OR JOINT VENTURE

Nothing in this Licence is intended to, or shall be deemed to, establish any partnership or joint venture between any of the parties, nor authorise any party to make or enter into any commitments for or on behalf of any other party.

26. NOTICES

- 26.1 Alterations to this Agreement and to the schedules/appendices/sections to this Agreement are only valid if they are recorded in writing and signed by both parties (the parties acknowledge electronic signatures will suffice).
- 26.2 Any notice required to be given under this Licence shall be in writing and shall be delivered personally, or sent by pre-paid first-class post, recorded delivery

or by commercial courier, to each party required to receive the notice as set out below:

or as otherwise specified by the relevant party by notice in writing to each other party.

26.3 Any notice shall be deemed to have been duly received:

- (a) if delivered personally, when left at the address and for the contact referred to in this Clause;
- (b) if sent by pre-paid first-class post or recorded delivery, at 9.00 am on the second business day after posting; or
- (c) if delivered by commercial courier, on the date and at the time that the courier's delivery receipt is signed.
- (d) if sent by email, 24 hours after being sent.

26.4 The provisions of this Clause shall not apply to the service of any proceedings or other documents in any legal action.

27. GOOD FAITH RESOLUTION

27.1 If there are any disputes or disagreements regarding the terms and conditions of this Licence, Emerald and the Licensee agree to work in good faith to resolve the issue.

28. GOVERNING LAW AND JURISDICTION

28.1 This Licence and any dispute or claim arising out of or in connection with it or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims) shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of Austria.

28.2 The parties irrevocably agree that the Courts of Austria shall have exclusive jurisdiction to settle any dispute or claim that arises out of or in connection with this Licence or its subject matter or formation (including non-contractual disputes or claims).

29. RE-USE OF AUTHOR WORK

29.1 Emerald offers open access of individual author works, subject to prior agreement and payment in advance of a fixed one-off charge. Details of this service are available from Emerald on request.

29.2 Notwithstanding any terms or conditions to the contrary in any author agreement between Authors and Emerald, whose work (Work) is accepted for publication within the Licensed Materials shall retain the non-exclusive, irrevocable, royalty-free right to re-use their Work for scholarly and educational purposes in the following ways, and subject to the following restrictions:

30.2 In consideration of the fee(s), Emerald will issue 57 Vouchers for 2026, 60 Vouchers for 2027, 60 Vouchers for 2028, 60 Vouchers for 2029 (optional year) for redemption by Eligible Authors. For the avoidance of doubt, the total number of Vouchers specified above shall apply in aggregate across all Participating

Institutional Members and not on an individual Participating Institutional Member basis.

30.3 The obligation for Emerald to issue the number of Vouchers stated in any year is conditional on the Licence Fees payable by the Participating Institutional Members collectively for any year falling within the Annual Revenue Range as set out in the following table:

30.5 The Vouchers expire after the period(s) stated (calendar years as set out in clause 30.2 above) and cannot be used in subsequent periods.

30.6 Authors affiliated to Participating Institutional Members (each an **Eligible Author**) will be eligible to use the Vouchers for articles accepted for publication pursuant to the terms of this Agreement:

- (a) in any Emerald subscription journal supporting Gold Open Access options on www.emerald.com/insight that the Eligible Author's

Participating Institutional Member has subscribed to in the relevant period (as set out in Schedule 1); or

- (b) in any Emerald fully gold open access journal (as set out in Schedule 1).

- 30.7 Emerald shall inform Eligible Authors about the availability of Vouchers following article acceptance and will allocate to Eligible Content on a first come first served basis.
- 30.8 A condition of redemption is that the Eligible Authors must agree that, and grant all necessary rights to enable, the Eligible Content to be published on a Creative Commons Attribution 4.0 International (CC BY 4.0) licence (or other open access licence agreed between the Eligible Author and the Publisher).
- 30.9 In the case of multiple authorship, an Eligible Author must be the corresponding author.
- 30.10 In the event that all Vouchers are redeemed in any Calendar Year during the Term, Eligible Authors will be entitled to self-fund publication at a rate 10% less than the current article processing charge at the point of acceptance if they are intending to publish via the options at clause 30.6 above.
- 30.11 The Parties acknowledge that Eligible Authors have the option to publish Eligible Articles as envisaged by this clause, or a standard license to publish (i.e on subscription basis). Emerald will promote the option of publishing under Emerald's Gold Open Access service and inform authors if they are eligible for use of a Voucher if and when their submission is accepted.
- 30.12 Emerald will identify Eligible Authors following acceptance of Eligible Content for publication using industry standard methods of identifying affiliation, including Ringgold ID. The Parties acknowledge and agree that nothing in this Agreement, in particular but not limited to the definition or identification of an Eligible Author, affects how the affiliation of the author or Eligible Author is stated in the published article, which will be determined by Emerald's policy from time to time.
- 30.13 If Emerald allocates a Voucher to Eligible Content that was not authored by an Eligible Author, it will add a Voucher to the remaining balance following notification from the Licensee. For the avoidance of doubt, the Eligible Content will remain published on the open access licence that was applied at publication.

- 30.14 If Emerald fails to identify an Eligible Author (the author having provided affiliation information) and Eligible Content is published without the use of a Voucher and the Eligible Author requests rectification, Emerald will allocate a Voucher to the Eligible Content and publish it under a Creative Commons Attribution 4.0 International (CC BY 4.0) licence.
- 30.15 The Parties agree that Vouchers shall be applied retrospectively and therefore the Eligible Content of an Eligible Author that was published prior to the date that this Agreement was entered into but within a period that Vouchers are available under this Agreement, will be allocated a Voucher and published on Creative Commons Attribution 4.0 International (CC BY 4.0) licence subject to the Eligible Author's approval.
- 30.16 Emerald will, subject to the Licensee requesting access to such information as detailed below, make available to the Licensee information about Content from Eligible Authors for the period 01 January 2026 to 31 December 2028. The information shall include (if applicable):
